HB 2287
Status

RELATING TO THE PETROLEUM INDUSTRY. EEP, CPC, FIN
Repeals the petroleum industry information reporting requirements, the petroleum industry monitoring, analysis, and reporting program, and the PIMAR special fund.

HB 2451
Status

RELATING TO NET ZERO ENERGY BUILDING PERMITTING. EEP, FIN
Requires priority state and county permitting for buildings that consume zero net energy and have no carbon emissions.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
