<u>HB 2962</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Temporarily defers deductions against a taxpayer's net income tax liability for claims under the Technology Infrastructure Renovation Tax Credit and High Technology Business Investment Tax Credit between July 1, 2010, and June 30, 2013.	FIN
<u>HB 1947</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Repeals applicability of state income tax to rollovers made by employees of state and county agencies and tax exempt organizations from qualifying annuity plans and qualifying deferred compensation plans to eligible retirement plans or individual retirement accounts.	FIN
<u>HB 2153</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Assesses a surcharge tax on all soft drinks sold in the State.	FIN
<u>HB 2736</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT. Requires at least eighty per cent of workers on public works and construction contracts to be Hawaii residents.	FIN
<u>HB 2741</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS. Requires the DLNR to issue a commercial permit to the owner of a commercial vessel with a mooring permit under certain conditions.	FIN

Status

RELATING TO DAMS AND RESERVOIRS.

FIN

Establishes standards for the permitting, inspection, and maintenance of dams, reservoirs, and their appurtenant structures. Establishes the dam rehabilitation loan revolving fund and loan program. Authorizes the issuance of revenue bonds to fund the dam rehabilitation loan program.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


