| <u>HB 2170, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR226-10)</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO VITAL STATISTICS. Requires the department of health to provide each county's real property assessment division a monthly list of death records at no charge. Effective July 1, 2020. | HLT, FIN |
| <u>HB 2171</u> <u>(HSCR127-10)</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO CONVEYANCE TAX. Requires the director of taxation to provide the administrator of each county's real property assessment division with an image of all certificates of conveyances filed with the bureau of conveyances. | WLO, FIN |
| <u>HB 2583</u> <u>(HSCR322-10)</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO IMPOUNDED VESSELS. Clarifies that all costs and expenses associated with the disposal of an impounded unauthorized vessel by the Department of Land and Natural Resources shall be borne by the vessel owner. | WLO, JUD, FIN |
| <u>HB 2449, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR253-10)</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO COUNTY BOARDS OF WATER SUPPLY. Allow officials other than a County Auditor to issue warrants to disburse funds for a Board of Water Supply. Allows a Board of Water Supply to prescribe powers and duties for a Manager and Chief Engineer to disburse funds. | WLO, FIN |
| <u>HB 2689, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR254-10)</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WATER SYSTEMS. Exempts conveyances of agricultural water systems to Board of Agriculture from subdivision requirements; requires notice of conveyance to applicable county. Effective July 1, 2020. | WLO/AGR, FIN |

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW



Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least **24 hours prior** to the hearing with a transmittal cover indicating:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee the comments are directed to;
- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

FAX: For comments less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 586-6001 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islanders without a computer to submit testimony through e-mail or the Web); or

WEB: For comments less than 4MB in size, transmit from the Web page at <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/emailtestimony>.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
