<u>SB 2469, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR846-10)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND. Appropriates moneys from the emergency and budget reserve fund to maintain levels of programs for education, human services, and health. Effective July 1, 2050.	HUS/HLT, FIN
<u>SB 2650, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR868-10)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES. Requires Medicaid contracts between the department of human services and Medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractors to contain provisions affecting the reimbursement obligations in the policies between the Medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractors and the home and community-based case management agencies. Convenes a task force to determine the feasibility of the Department of Human Services proposed reorganization. Effective January 1, 2050.	HUS/HLT, FIN
