<u>HB 2480</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HISTORIC PLACES. Defines archaeological site or archaeological feature. Requires the historic preservation division of DLNR to report on the state and historical significance of an archaeological site if inadvertently destroyed. Provides for penalties for wilful alteration or destruction of an archaeological site or archaeological feature on the Hawaii or national register of historic places.	HAW/WLO, FIN
<u>HB 1961</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE KAHO'OLAWA REHABILITATION TRUST FUND. Imposes a surcharge on ocean recreational activity tours at Molokini island, including the reefs and reef lands off the shore of the island, to be deposited in the Kaho'olawe rehabilitation trust fund.	HAW/WLO, FIN
<u>HB 2240</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS. Transfers the functions and duties of the historic preservation division of DLNR relating to Hawaiian burial sites to the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.	HAW/WLO, FIN



<u>HB 2242</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS. Transfers the functions and duties of the historic preservation division and the Kaho`olawe island reserve commission relating to Hawaiian burial sites to the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. Establishes special fund. Funds operation through conveyance tax revenues. Includes cave burials and burial sites.	HAW/WLO, FIN
<u>HB 2484</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Establishes fines for the knowing destruction of heiau on private lands.	HAW/WLO, JUD
<u>HB 2672</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS. Resolves claims and disputes relating to the portion of income and proceeds from the lands of the public land trust for use by the office of Hawaiian affairs between 11/7/1978, and 7/1/2008; requires payment of cash to the office of Hawaiian affairs.	HAW/WLO, JUD, FIN
<u>HB 2241</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC TRUST LANDS. Provides for transfer of management, control, and title of public trust land to sovereign Hawaiian entity upon recognition by the United States and State of Hawaii.	HAW/WLO, JUD, FIN

Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.


