What is DHHL's plan to sustain sufficient sums available for the following purposes as defined in The Constitution of the State of Hawaii, Article 12, Section 1, for purposes of (1) development of home, agriculture, farm, and ranch lots; (2) home, agriculture, aquaculture, farm and ranch loans; (3) rehabilitation projects to include, but not limited to, educational, economic, political, social and cultural processes by which the general welfare and conditions of native Hawaiians are thereby improved.
