<u>HB 2488</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HOMELESS. Increases by 10% the conveyance tax on the sale of luxury homes over \$700,000 to finance the purchase and maintenance of state parks to serve the homeless.	HSG/WLO, FIN
<u>HB 2526</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING. Expedites the construction of affordable housing units by requiring ministerial permits associated with the project to be issued by the state or county within forty-five days of acceptance of the permit application for the project. 
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WEB: For comments less than 4MB in size, transmit from the Web page at <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/emailtestimony>.
