DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB 2126 Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO DENTAL SERVICES.</u> Prohibits a accident and health or sickness insurer, mutual benefit society, health maintenance organization, or dental service organization from requiring a dentist who provides services to its subscribers to accept a fee set by the accident and health or sickness insurer, mutual benefit society, health maintenance organization, or dental service organization unless the services are covered under the applicable subscriber agreement. SB 2492 Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO PRACTICE OF PHARMACY.</u> <u>Amends the definition of "practice of pharmacy" by changing the age of persons to whom immunizations are administered from 18 to nine years of age with parental consent.</u>	<u>HTH, CPN</u> <u>[Measure added on 02-08-10]</u>
SB 2770 Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO REMOTE DISPENSING PHARMACY.</u> <u>Clarifies the definitions of "remote dispensing machine" and "remote dispensing pharmacy".</u>	<u>HTH, CPN</u> <u>[Measure added on 02-08-10]</u>
SB 2726 Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO TIME FRAMES TO REGAIN FITNESS TO PROCEED.</u> <u>Establishes specific time frames for a commitment or release on conditions when unfit defendants are charged with petty misdemeanors (60 days), and non-violent misdemeanors (120 days).</u>	<u>HTH, JGO</u> <u>[Measure added on 02-08-10]</u>
SB 2725 Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO CONFIDENTIALITY OF FORENSIC MENTAL HEALTH EXAMINATION REPORTS.</u> <u>Requires courts to maintain mental health examination reports as confidential documents, subject to certain specific exceptions for limited distribution of the reports.</u>	<u>HTH, JGO</u> <u>[Measure added on 02-08-10]</u>
SB 2380 Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO BOTTLED WATER.</u> <u>Requires all bottled water to be labeled with the date of bottling.</u>	<u>HTH, CPN</u> <u>[Measure added on 02-08-10]</u>

RELATING TO ANATOMICAL GIFTS.

Prevents persons with HIV or AIDS from being automatically excluded from organ transplants due to their diagnosis; requires that any procurement organization in the State to maintain donor lists including high risk donors and persons with HIV or AIDS.

RELATING TO MEDICAL GIFTS.

Bans drug or device manufacturers or any wholesale distributor of medical devices from offering gifts to health care providers, unless excepted. Requires disclosure of permissible gifts to the director of commerce and consumer affairs. Makes disclosures publicly available.
