| <u>Testimony</u> | Updates, organizes, and clarifies current campaign financing laws. | |

| <u>SB 2252</u> | RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCING. | JGO |
| <u>Testimony</u> | Amends law relating to ballot issue committees. Defines automated phone call and requires certain information to be stated at the beginning of such phone calls. Amends the definition of advertisement. Repeals the campaign spending commission's authority to adopt a code of fair campaign practices as part of its rules. Requires advertising notices and disclaimers to be included on every web page that contains an advertisement. | |

<u>SB 2154</u>	RELATING TO ADULT PROBATION RECORDS.	JGO
<u>Testimony</u>	Authorizes disclosure of adult probation records to a defendant's doctor when substance use may compromise medical treatment and to law enforcement to report a crime or crime-related information.

<u>SB 2878</u>	RELATING TO TRUSTEES.	JGO
<u>Testimony</u>	Authorizes trustees of revocable living trusts to base their reasonable compensation on the compensation levels allowed for trustees of estates.

<u>SB 2879</u>	RELATING TO COURT REPORTERS.	JGO
<u>Testimony</u>	Authorizes certified shorthand reporters to administer oaths or affirmations and to perform the duties of a deposition officer.
