Establishes limits on requests for proposals from health and human services providers for QUEST contracts that exceed \$100,000,000 and commence after the term of the agency director expires. Takes effect July 1, 2020. (SD1)	HMS/HTH, JGO
<a href="#"><u>HB 2441, HD2, SD1</u></a> <a href="#"><u>(SSCR2788)</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Testimony</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status</u></a>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Specifies that gifts made to the State shall not constitute or require a procurement contract. (SD1)	TIA/WTL, JGO
