<u>SB 2840, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR2473)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT. Requires at least eighty per cent of workers on certain public works contracts and construction procurements to be Hawaii residents. Requires contractor to provide proof of compliance, if challenged. Effective date 07/01/2050. (SD2)	EBM/LAB, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
