— <u>Testimony</u>	Allows for additional authorized personnel to disburse funds of the board of water supply.

— <u>Testimony</u>	Creates a pilot project to transfer jurisdiction of state highways in Maui county from the state department of transportation to the Maui department of transportation.

<u>SB 2182</u>	RELATING TO PARKING SPACES RESERVED FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.	TIA, JGO
— <u>Testimony</u>	Clarifies that a violation is committed by a driver or registered owner of a vehicle. Allows citations to be handed to the violator or affixed to the vehicle if the vehicle is unattended. Clarifies that a citation may be mailed when the violator refuses the citation.

<u>SB 2845</u>	RELATING TO HIGHWAYS.	TIA, JGO
— <u>Testimony</u>	Prohibits medium speed electric vehicles to be operated at speeds of more than thirty five miles per hour. Prohibits operation on highways with a posted speed limit of more than 45 mph or on the H1, H2, and H3 freeways.

— <u>Testimony</u>	Increases the grounds for license revocations.

~~Requires liquor commissions in any county with a population over 500,000, and authorizes liquor commissions in any county with a population of 500,000 or less, to regulate BYOB establishments by issuance of permits. Requires adoption of rules regarding permit applications, fees, and renewals. Permits consumption of liquor in BYOB establishments only until 10:00 p.m. Authorizes liquor commission to enforce liquor laws regarding BYOB establishments.~~
