<u>SB 2449</u> (SSCR2040) <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSING. Makes the statutory requirements for provisional driver's licenses for persons under the age of eighteen permanent.	TRN, JUD
<u>SB 2201, SD1</u> (SSCR2010) <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES. Repeals obsolete provisions relating to annual motor vehicle registration. (SD1)	TRN, FIN
<u>SB 2375, SD1</u> (SSCR2112) <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HIGHWAYS. Prohibits vending at scenic lookouts, without a vending concession permit. (SD1)	TRN, JUD
<u>SB 2358, SD1</u> (SSCR2363) <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION ENERGY INITIATIVES. Provides that high occupancy vehicle lanes may be used by electric vehicles capable of driving at least fifty-five miles per hour, regardless of the number of occupants. (SD1)	TRN, EEP, JUD
<u>SB 2756, SD2</u> (SSCR2486) <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO COST SHARING IN THE RELOCATION AND UNDERGROUNDING OF UTILITY FACILITIES. Allocates cost share among highway agencies and utilities for projects involving the removal, relocation, replacement, or reconstruction of utility facilities that border state or county highways. Clarifies federal funding share for cost of undergrounding utility facilities. Effective 7/1/50. (SD2)	TRN, CPC, FIN
<u>SB 2863, SD2</u> (SSCR2468) <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE TAX LIEN AND ENCUMBRANCE RECORD. Enables encumbrance of motor vehicle titles for outstanding judgments payable to the State or a county by allowing recordation in a county director of finance's "tax lien and encumbrance record" with an exemption for state or county agencies from paying the statutory fee. (SD2)	TRN, JUD, FIN



DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.


EMAIL: For comments less than 5 pages in length, transmit to TRNtestimony@Capitol.hawaii.gov ; or
