| <u>HB 1882</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO SHORELINE SETBACK.<br>Prohibits inclusion of accreted lands in determining shoreline setback line in counties with population over 500,000.  | WLO      |
| <u>HB 1973</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO DESECRATION.<br>Amends the state of mind for the offense of desecration of a burial site from intentional to negligent.  | WLO, JUD |
| <u>HB 2019</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO PARKS.<br>Allows the governor to transfer the Mauna Kea and Hapuna Beach state recreational areas from the State to the county of Hawaii.  | WLO, FIN |
| <u>HB 2270</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.<br>Changes system of selection for the recreation-residence use leases in state parks and forest reserves in counties with a population of less than 100,000 from an action to a lottery.  | WLO, FIN |
| <u>HB 2449</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO COUNTY BOARDS OF WATER SUPPLY.<br>Allow officials other than a county auditor to issue warrants to disburse funds for a board of water supply. Allows a board of water supply to prescribe powers and duties for a manager and chief engineer regarding the disbursement of funds.       | WLO, FIN |
| <u>HB 2582</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO VESSELS AT ALA WAI AND KEEHI BOAT HARBORS.<br>Authorizes moorage for commercial vessels and commercial vessel activities in the Ala Wai and Keehi Boat Harbors and adjusts fees for permittees of vessels that are used for a place of principal habitation in state small boat harbors. | WLO, FIN |



HB 2835  
Status

RELATING TO THE BUREAU OF CONVEYANCES.  
Requires registrar to provide adjoining landowner, upon request, any information of record relating to the management, control, and title of any public highway, waterway, or water course.

HB 2907  
Status

RELATING TO THE STATE PARK SYSTEM.  
Prohibits the use of ATV's within the state park system without the use of a safety helmet. Prohibits minors from operating ATV's within the state park system.

HB 2561  
Status

The following measure(s) were previously heard on **February 1, 2010**.  
RELATING TO LANDS CONTROLLED BY THE STATE.  
Restores the law with regard to non-ceded lands controlled by the State, to what it was prior to the passage of Act 176, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009.

PAPER: 1 copies (including an original) to Room 438 in the State Capitol;


FAX: For comments less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 586-8504 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islanders without a computer to submit testimony through e-mail or the Web); or

WEB: For comments less than 4MB in size, transmit from the Web page at <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/emailtestimony>.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
