APPLICATION PROCESSING.

EBM, WLO

Establishes maximum time periods for designated agencies to process permit and other applications before it is deemed granted if not acted upon; authorizes each county to contract with a third-party reviewer to streamline the processing of applications; clarifies that previously approved projects that do not impact historic properties are not subject to subsequent reviews by the SHPD. Effective January 1, 2112.

RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS.

WLO

Requires commercial permit holders who disembark fare-paying passengers entering upon any public or quasi-public real property to comply with regulations applicable to such areas.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


