<a href="#">HB2689 HD1</a> <a href="#">(HSCR632-10)</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WATER SYSTEMS. Exempts conveyances of agricultural water systems to Board of Agriculture from subdivision requirements; requires notice of conveyance to applicable county. Effective July 1, 2020. (HB2689 HD1)	WTL/TIA
<a href="#">HB2741 HD1</a> <a href="#">(HSCR502-10)</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS. Requires a permittee of certain commercial fishing vessels to pay a fee two times the moorage fee of a recreational vessel. Allows a person to transfer stock or interest in a corporation or business entity operating a commercial fishing vessel while allowing the corporation or business entity to retain its mooring permit under certain circumstances. Defines "commercial fishing activity." Effective July 1, 2020. (HB2741 HD1)	WTL, WAM
<a href="#">HB1818 HD2</a> <a href="#">(HSCR619-10)</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO COGNITIVE RESTRUCTURING. <u>Requires the Department of Public Safety to ensure that reentry/reintegration programs in Hawaii's correctional facilities offer cognitive behavioral theory with native Hawaiian holistic interventions to address domestic violence, addictions, self-mastery through identity, and community connections for successful transitions back into the community. Effective July 1, 2020. (HB1818 HD2)</u>	<u>PSM/WTL, WAM</u> [Measure added on 3/16/2010]
