<p>PELL GRANTS</p>	<p>The stimulus bill increased the maximum Pell Grant allowable per student by \$500 (to \$5,350 for 2009-10).</p> <p>Funding is awarded to the student based on financial need. Because a student's financial need may change year to year and because the number of student applicants for financial aid may also change year to year, it is not possible to attribute increases in Pell Grant funding to the ARRA stimulus bill.</p>																								
<p>FEDERAL WORK STUDY</p>	<p>The stimulus bill provided for an additional \$200 million for the Federal Work Study program. However, most of the UH campuses did not see an increase in their Federal Work Study allocation.</p>
