<u>SB2016</u>	RELATING TO LIFE SETTLEMENTS. Extends the Life Settlements Act for an additional five years.	CPC, FIN
<u>SB2017</u>	RELATING TO INSURANCE CLAIMS ADJUSTERS. Allows a claims adjuster to take an examination approved by the Risk Management Agency of the United States Department of Agriculture in order to qualify for a limited insurance adjuster's license.	CPC
<u>SB2018</u>	RELATING TO NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS. Removes limitations pertaining to reasonableness for service charges relating to dishonored checks.	CPC

<u>SB2524, SD1</u>	RELATING TO ISLAND BURIAL COUNCILS. Authorizes the governor to waive the requirements that the Molokai island burial council membership include geographic region, development, and large property owner representatives. (SD1)	HAW, WLO
<u>SB2596, SD1</u>	RELATING TO GROUP LIFE INSURANCE. Specifies conditions for group life insurance policies offered or delivered within the State. (SD1)	CPC
<u>SB2602</u>	RELATING TO REAL ESTATE LICENSEES. Requires that a real estate broker or salesperson possess a high school diploma or its equivalent. Increases the continuing education requirement for real estate licensees from ten to twenty hours in a two-year period.	CPC
<u>SB2699, SD1</u>	RELATING TO RESTORATION OF CERTAIN FORFEITED PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL LICENSES. Establishes times limits to restore forfeited chiropractic examiner licenses and individual real estate broker and salesperson licenses. (SD1)	CPC/JUD
<u>SB2754</u>	RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING. Conform sections 286-240(g) and (h), HRS to the federal commercial driver licensing law to meet the requirements of 49 CFR Section 383.51(e) before September 4, 2010, as required by Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU). <u>SB2759</u>	RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSING. Differentiate category four motor vehicles from commercial motor vehicles to clarify that category four motor vehicles do not include commercial motor vehicles as defined in section 286-2, HRS.	TRN, JUD

RELATING TO CAPTIVE INSURANCE COMPANIES.
Amends the frequency of statutorily required captive insurance company examinations from once every three years to once every five years, unless otherwise required by the Insurance Commissioner. Requires risk retention captive insurance companies to undergo examination within three years of formation. Eliminates reference to a repealed provision on minimum surplus requirements for captive insurance companies. Requires protected cell accounts established by sponsored captive insurance companies to be operated only under the forms of business organizations authorized by the Insurance Commissioner. (SD1)
