SB1309, SD2	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE WAIANAE COAST COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH CENTER Makes an appropriation for emergency services at Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center. Effective 7/1/2099.	HLT, FIN
SB2026, SD2	RELATING TO PAROLE. Establishes a parole service fee. Establishes a parole service special fund. Specifies proportional deposits of the parole service fee into the parole services special fund and the crime victim compensation special fund.	PBS, FIN
SB2081, SD2	RELATING TO LITTER CONTROL. Increases the fine for littering. Requires moneys to be deposited into the county general fund for the county that imposed the fine or if the fine is imposed by the state, into a special account in the state general fund for use by the state law enforcement agency that issued the littering citation. HLT. FIN

Makes moneys appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010 to match the federal disproportionate share hospital allowance allocated to the State available for expenditure in the 2009-2011 fiscal biennium; authorizes some appropriated funds to be used to obtain matching federal disproportionate share hospital allowance for prior fiscal year expenditures by the State. Effective 7/1/2050.

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING. SB2110, SD2

HSG/WLO, JUD

Expedites the construction of affordable housing units by requiring ministerial permits associated with the project to be issued by the state or county within sixty days of receipt of a permit application deemed to be complete by the receiving state or county agency. Effective 7/1/50. (SD2)

SB2111, SD2 RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

HSG/WLO

Shortens the time period within which counties may accept or reject requests for dedication of infrastructure for affordable housing to sixty days, commencing upon receipt by the appropriate county council of a complete application for dedication request, and subject to certain conditions. Effective 7/1/50. (SD2)

RELATING TO VETERANS. SB2139, SD2

EBM, FIN

Requires the director of the office of veterans' services to act on behalf of deceased veterans found to be indigent at the time of death and without surviving immediate family members to ensure the burial or cremation and interment of the veteran's remains in a state veterans cemetery. (SD2)

RELATING TO JUDICIARY FEES. SB2155, SD1

JUD, FIN

Authorizes the judiciary to pay a service fee to an electronic payment service provider and to pass the fee on to the customer. (SD1)

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH SB2175, SD1 BENEFITS TRUST FUND.

LAB. FIN

Requires one trustee of the employer-union health benefits trust fund to be occupied by a representative appointed by the Hawaii council of mayors to represent county interests. Effective

<u>SB2271, SD2</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS. <u>SB2274, SD2</u>	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST HAWAII PACIFIC HEALTH. Authorizes the issuance of SPRBs to assist Hawaii Pacific Health in financing, refinancing, and/or reimbursing costs related to the acquisition or construction of health care facilities. Effective date 07/01/2050.	HLT, FIN
<u>SB2277, SD2</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY. Removes most procedural requirements preliminary to hearings for evictions of tenants of public housing projects and requires instead the Hawaii public housing authority to submit written notice, in accordance with federal law, to delinquent tenants. Clarifies that for federal low-income housing, hearings shall be conducted by an eviction board. Effective 07/01/2099.	HSG, JUD

Establishes a refundable Hawaii residential housing income tax credit for qualified taxpayers who purchase a qualified principal residence on or after 4/1/2010, and before 1/1/2012, that is payable to the qualified taxpayer in two equal installments over the immediately following two taxable years. Effective 7/1/2050.	HSG, FIN
SB2598, SD2	RELATING TO INSURANCE. Requires health insurers to promptly pay claims for services to medicaid recipients, by repealing the exemption for medicaid claims from the clean claims law. SB2599, SD2	RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE. Mandates health insurance coverage to screen for colorectal cancer by colonoscopy or another screening modality graded A or B by the United States Preventive Services Task Force. (SD2)	HLT, CPC, FIN

SB2607, SD2 RELATING TO ACTIVITY DESKS.

TCI, CPC/JUD

Establishes record keeping and trust account requirements for client trust accounts held by activity desks. Clarifies that activity desks shall include registration numbers on all advertising materials. Requires an activity desk to obtain full payment for activities prior to or at the time reservations are made, subject to certain exceptions. Increases required amount of bond or letter of credit to \$250,000. (SD2)

<u>SB2611, SD2</u> RELATING TO VITAL STATISTICS.

HLT, FIN

Requires the clerk and real property assessment division of each county, at agreed upon intervals, to provide a list of names of all registered voters and individuals receiving real property tax exemptions to the department of health. Upon receipt, requires department to verify the date of death for any person on the list. Authorizes the department of health to charge fees for verifications. Effective 7/1/2099.

SB2649, SD2 RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROJECTS.

Extends the sunset provision in Act 138, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, relating to providing funding to the University of Hawaii to construct or renovate housing units. (SD2)

SB2659, SD2 RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT

FIN

Relocates the recycled oil product preference provisions within the procurement code and repeals part XIII where these provisions were previously located. Changes the preference for biofuel and lubricating and industrial oil with the highest percentage of recycled oil from mandatory to permissive.

SB2661, SD2 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE JUD, FIN

STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

Makes appropriations for claims against the State, its officers, and its employees. Effective July 1, 2050.

SB2676, SD1 RELATING TO THE ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

Provides funds for settlement of a claim between Aloha Tower Development Corporation and Kenneth H. Hughes, Inc., by making an appropriation from Aloha Tower Fund, which has the

effect of increasing its budget ceiling. (SD1)

REFERRAL SB2685, SD1 RELATING TO UNCLAIMED PROPERTY. **FIN** Requires holders of unclaimed property to remit all property with their November 1 report and deletes reference to a specific number of days in which claims must be acted upon; also makes a technical correction by referencing the Unclaimed Property Trust Fund. RELATING TO THE PAYMENT OF EMPLOYEES' LAB. FIN SB2691, SD1 RETIREMENT SYSTEM BENEFITS. Requires by March 1, 2011, all retirees and beneficiaries of the ERS to designate a financial institution account into which retirement benefit may be deposited. (SD1) RELATING TO A MAJOR DISASTER TRUST ACCOUNT. SB2702, SD2 PBS, FIN Allows federal reimbursement moneys for disaster relief to be deposited into a trust account for future disaster relief. Prohibits lapsing into general fund. (SD2) RELATING TO IMMUNIZATION. HLT, FIN SB2729, SD2 Authorizes the Department of Health to establish and maintain a single repository of immunization records to be designated as the "Hawaii Immunization Registry" in order to aid, coordinate, and help promote efficient and cost-effective screening, prevention, and control of vaccine preventable diseases, including pandemic influenza. RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING. TRN, FIN SB2757, SD2 Extends the term of a commercial driver's license (CDL) for persons 21 years through 71 years from 6 years to 8 years to prepare for the REAL ID Act, which is a nationwide effort to improve the integrity and security of state-issued driver licenses and identification cards, to help fight terrorism and reduce fraud. Appropriate \$8,000 out of the state highway fund. Effective 9/1/2050. (SD2) SB2780, SD2 RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LANDS. WLO/AGR, JUD Protects agriculturally suitable lands on Oahu (lands with productivity ratings of "A" or "B"); provides for mandatory extension of agricultural leases. (SD2) RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. SB2786, SD2 EDN, FIN Requires the department of education to establish and implement a searchable budget database website that will be made publicly

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available no later than 07/01/2011. Effective 01/01/2050.

SB2884, SD2	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS. Appropriates moneys to fund collective bargaining cost items for collective bargaining unit (10) relating to the employer contributions to the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund. Effective 07/01/2050.	LAB, FIN
SB2885, SD2	RELATING TO HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNTS. Establishes a task force to evaluate the current state of health savings accounts options in Hawaii's health insurance market and to explore ways to expand access to these accounts in Hawaii. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)	HLT, LAB, FIN
SB2903, SD2	RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE COLLEGE. Requires the department of education, the charter school administrative office, and the Hawaiian language college at the University of Hawaii at Hilo to enter into an agreement regarding the Hawaiian language college's functions related to Nawahiokalani'opu'u school and other laboratory schools. SB2919, SD1 RELATING TO THE HAWAII STATE HOSPITAL.

HLT, PBS, FIN

Requires the department of public safety to provide security at Hawaii state hospital. Requires report from department of health, in collaboration with department of public safety, to the legislature on the plan for the provision of short and long-term security for the needs of the forensic population of the Hawaii state hospital. Effective 7/1/2050.

SB2954, SD2 RELATING TO TRANSFER OF STATE HIGHWAYS.

TRN, FIN

Creates a pilot project to transfer maintenance functions of state highways in Maui county from the state department of transportation to the Maui department of public works. (SD2)
