The decrease in 2006 was apparent across all 4 counties and greatest in Kauai(8 injuries in 2005 to 1 in 2006) and Honolulu(37 injuries in 2005 to 14 in 2006).

The reduction in fireworks related injuries is probably due to a decrease in the use of fireworks, as indicated by the number of permits that were issued. According to the Honolulu Fire Depart. 229 permits were issued for July 4, 2006 in Honolulu, compared to 382 in 2005. (The 2005 total is adjusted for 2 individuals who purchased 700 permits.) The 40% decrease in permits in Honolulu is comparable to the 62% decrease in fireworks related injuries in the County.
