Criminal Investigations

There were 8 criminal investigations initiated relating to fireworks violations since January 1, 2005: 2 in the Puna district, 1 in the Hāmākua district stemming from a fire caused by fireworks, 2 in the Kona district, 2 in the South Kohala district, and 1 in the North Kohala district.

More than two-thirds(71%) of the patients were males. The age of the the patients ranged from 0 to 40 years, but most (80%) were 14 years or younger.

*71% of the patients were injured while setting off or holding the firework; the rest were injured while observing fireworks.

*97% of the injuries were burns. There was also 1 blast injury and 1 laceration. Hands and fingers were the most commonly injured body areas (66% of patients).

*82% of the injuries occurred on July 4th; there were 5 injuries on July 5th, and 1 on July 3rd. 50% of the injuries were sustained during the 3-hour period of 7:00pm to 10:00pm, on July 4th, and 69% were sustained during 7:00pm to midnight.

*Fireworks related injuries during this July 4th period were much less common than those recorded through similar surveillance during the previous New Year period(72injuries). However, the July 4, 2004 total is almost double that recorded for July 4, 2003 (17).

*The age of the victims ranged from 1 to 42 years, but most(41, 72%) were 14 years or younger. (43, 75%) were under 18. Four were between the ages of 6 and 9. Male patients(41,72%) outnumbered females almost 3 to 1.

*Most(47, 89% of the 53 patients for whom this information was provided) were injured while setting off or holding the firework, and 6 others were injured while observing fireworks.

*Almost all of the injuries were burns; there was 1 injury described as a "blast injury". Hands and fingers(47 injuries) were the most commonly injured body areas. There were also 5 injuries to the legs and 5 to the head/face area, including 2 eye injuries.

*Most (46, 81%) of the injuries occurred on July 4th, but there were also 5 injuries on July 3rd, and 6 on July 5th. Half(23 of 46) of the injuries on July 4th were sustained during the 2-hour period of 8:00p.m. to 10:00p.m.

*The 57 injuries this July 4th is by far the highest total observed since DOH began this surveillance in 2003. The annual totals have nearly doubled each year from 17 in 2003, to 32 in 2004, to the present total of 57. The increase in 2005 was apparent across all 4 counties in the state.

*The age of the victims ranged from 2 to 30 years, 14(70%) were 15 years or younger. 71% were under the age of 18. 6 (29%) were between the ages of 2 and 5. Male patients 18(78%) outnumbered females by a 4 to 1 ratio.

*15(75%) of the 20 patients for whom this information was provided were injured while setting off or holding the firework, and 5 others were injured while observing fireworks.

*21 of the injuries were burns; there was 1 blast injury and another described as "dust in the eyes". Hands and fingers (17 injuries) were the most injured body areas. There were also 5 injuries to the head area, including 3 eye injuries.

*All but 1 of the injuries occurred on July 4th. 47% of the injuries

*The age of the patients ranged from 4 to 30 years, (80%) were under age 18. Three patients were under 5 years of age and 6 were younger than 10. Male patients 12(75%) outnumbered females 4(25%) by a 3 to 1 ratio.

*14 of the 15 patients were injured while setting off or holding the firework, the other was an observer.

*All of the injuries were burns, and 14(88%) were burns to the hands. One patient suffered burns to the feet and another burns to the arms.

*All but 2 of the injuries occurred on July 4th. 7 of the 14 injuries on July 4th were sustained between 8:15 p.m. and 9:15 p.m.

*The age of the patients ranged from 5 to 49 years, but (59%) were under age 18. (84%) of the patients were males.

*18(90%) of the patients were injured while setting off or holding the firework; the other 2 were observers.

*88% of the injuries were burns, specifically burns to the hands. 2 patients suffered injuries ot their eyes.

*15 or 75% of the injuries occurred on July 4th and 5 on July 5th. 71% of the injuries on July 4th were sustained between 9:00 p.m. to 11:45 p.m.

*The total of 20 injuries is comparable to totals documented for the July 4th periods in 2007(17) and 2006 (23), but well below the totals for 2005 (57) and 2004 (32) injuries.

on July 4th were sustained between 8:00pm and 9:30pm.

*The 23 total injuries is less than half of the total of 57 recorded last year; a decrease of 60%. The current total is the 2nd lowest since surveillance began in 2003, when there were 17 injuries. The decrease in 2006 was apparent across all 4 counties and greatest in Kauai(8 injuries in 2005 to 1 in 2006) and Honolulu(37 injuries in 2005 to 14 in 2006).

The reduction in fireworks related injuries is probably due to a decrease in the use of fireworks, as indicated by the number of permits that were issued. According to the Honolulu Fire Depart. 229 permits were issued for July 4, 2006 in Honolulu, compared to 382 in 2005.(The 2005 total is adjusted for 2 individuals who purchased 700 permits.) The 40% decrease in permits in Honolulu is comparable to the 62% decrease in fireworks related injuries in the County.

*All of the patients were under 30 years of age, including 5 who were 14 or younger. (Age not known for one patient.)

*5 of the injuries were burns, to the hand (4 injuries). There were 2 blast injuries to the eye and face of patients, and 1 laceration.

*All of the patients took private transport to the emergency room (EMS not involved), and all were discharged from the emergency room (no hospital admissions).

*The 16 injuries this 4th of July is the lowest total in the 5 years this data has been collected. The current total is 30% lower than the 23 injuries documented in July 2006, and 3 times less than the total of 57 in July 2005.
