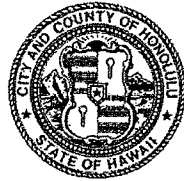



Thank you for the opportunity to testify.

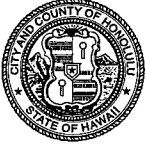

**Chair Taniguchi, Vice Chair Takamine and Members of the Committee:**

**The Downtown Neighborhood Board strongly supported HB 1862, as introduced, that removed the December 31, 2012 sunset date of Act 84, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004. We have concerns with HD1 of the bill, which just extends the sunset for two years to 2014. This important law makes it a violation to publicly urinate or defecate in the dense business and residential areas of Chinatown, Downtown and that part of Kaka'ako Mauka west of Ward Avenue.**

**The Downtown Neighborhood Board feels that continuing this specific violation is needed in our area because of the very real concern by our residents, workers and visitors that there are health and sanitation hazards that result from this conduct.**

**We have urged the City & County of Honolulu to take steps to increase the number and identification of public bathrooms in this area. To date, frankly, little has been done, but there are some public facilities available and we will continue to work to see that they are better identified.**

**In the meantime, we want to ensure that HPD has the enforcement tools necessary to cite someone who is blatantly acting so irresponsibly. At our monthly board meetings, HPD representatives are not able to easily count the number of citations they issue for this offense because it is a "violation" that does not result in an arrest, which is more easily tracked. But they have told us that it does work in many instances.**

**Help us keep our neighborhood, and your working neighborhood, as clean and safe as possible, by returning the total removal of the sunset date to this measure.**
