BOY SCOUTS TESTIMONY

HCR 320

Chair Ken Ito

We strongly urge passage of HCR 320 which supports the righting of a great wrong. Seven years ago a land exchange between the Aloha Council of the Boy Scouts of America and the State of Hawaii took place and was approved by the relevant bodies including the Hawaii State Legislature. All the necessary public announcements were published. Everything was properly vetted and approved by all the legal entities involved. A fair deal was struck, one which met all the standards of state and federal law, and which would also meet the high standards of the Boy Scout Oath and the Boy Scout Law.

However, an inadvertent error was made in 2004 which omitted the relevant tax map key number, tax map key number (1) 5-9-05-077 from the recorded conveyance documents. And because of that, questions are now raised because much later, in 2009, Act 176, section 171-50 was passed, which now requires that any exchange of public land for private land be subject to disapproval by 2/3rds vote of either House or simple majority of both Houses of the Legislature. The argument being put forward in opposition to the clear and fair understanding of the facts and the law, is that the inadvertent technical error has voided the entire complicated and otherwise entirely legal exchange, and so the Boy Scouts are just out of luck in being able to keep and to operate Camp Pupukea, the only facility that they have on Oahu.

House Concurrent Resolution 320 has it just right. The land exchange in question was properly done. The parties told and acted the truth, and did their best, and reached an honorable and complete agreement which is a benefit to all concerned.

We urge the passage of HCR 320.
