It is beyond my comprehension that the proposed ~~soda tax~~ ~~was~~ ~~rejected~~ to help save state human service jobs & services was ~~rejected~~ rejected. These would be ~~only~~ barely noticeable costs to consumers that would provide <sup>large</sup> ~~large~~ ongoing financial benefits to the state. Going into any kind of rainy day funds would deplete those funds with no means of replacement, so the help would be temporary & the money would not be available ~~to~~ for its intended purpose of dealing with hurricanes & other emergencies.

Also, ~~the~~ contact only by phone, fax, email, or mail removes the individual attention that clarifies questions ~~of~~ of both clients & eligibility workers. By depersonalizing this interaction, both workers & clients suffer.

As an example of the importance of personal contact, my foodstamps were accidentally cut off due to DHS error. With the help of my worker, who already knew me from previous in-person contact, I was able to receive my foodstamps within 3 weeks. With an impersonal, only automated system, this would not have happened.

With more need & fewer workers, everyone is already severely overstressed; cutting more jobs means more poverty, more need for state assistance, more stress & impossible to keep up with work for workers, & more poverty — an endlessly downspiraling cycle.

Keep the units open; hire more workers; raise money via soda or similar taxes. Protect Hawaii, don't destroy it.


On Maui we all need the personal assistance from our med-guest employees, especially the handicapped and medically challenged population.

To Whom It May Concern:


I am against the proposal of shutting down the BESSD and Medquest Offices on the neighbor islands and creating centralized offices on Oahu and the Big Island (EPOD). Although I am very aware of the State's need to balance the budget, I do not think that the proposal will save dollars. In fact, I strongly believe that in the long run, it will cost the State more to implement and run the program and will also cause much hardships for our clients, both monetary and medically.

Having staffed offices on all neighbor islands helps provide better and much needed access for our clients. A lot of them do not have computers, faxing capabilities, or even telephone. They rely on walking into our offices for help. For those that do have telephones, do you honestly expect them to wait patiently while listening to what I believe, will be some type of an automated system. Most automated systems have long recordings with too many different options and/or extensions. And if the lines are too busy, at the end of the recording, the caller may be told to "hang up and try your call again." This can lead to discouragement which could lead to someone not wanting to apply for much needed medical care. This will most definitely result in a higher number of people going to the hospital or emergency room unnecessarily. It could also lead to death. As drastic as that may sound, there are people I know of personally who are uninsured and will not seek medical attention because they are uninsured. If this proposal passes, people may be discouraged to apply due to the lack of accessibility.

Lastly, I am also worried about staff who will lose their jobs. We have been loyal to our employers. We, who have been helping others, may now need to seek help ourselves. Can you imagine how hard it will be for us? What if we have to apply for some type of State assistance ourselves? We take pride in our work and we can continue providing quality services to our clients. Yes, it can be hard at times and we may not be able to do all the work in one day but one thing is certain; when a client has an emergency and our office is open and available for them, more often than not, we end up assisting that person on the spot. There is a reason they walk into the office – most times they have a medical emergency and need help. If they qualify and are approved, that is one less person burdening the hospital or emergency room.

I urge you to join us and support us. Please do not approve this proposal but instead, just give us a chance to do the work – work that we are good at doing. There are other ways to battle the budget but there is no excuse to battle with our lives and our client's lives. The State will not save money this way.

Subject: Comments Regarding the Proposed Re-organization of the Med-Quest Division

Problem: The Centralization of Med-Quest Services to Honolulu and Hilo will eliminate personal contact with many qualified neighbor island claimants and is not consistent with the division mission ...”to develop and administer high-quality health care programs serving all eligible Hawaii residents”.

The current availability of advisors at the Maui office has proven to expedite claim servicing by resolving conflicts and misunderstandings regarding health care programs administered by the division. The effects of personal contact, in most cases, has reduced stress and frustration resulting in improved customer satisfaction. Based on our experience, one can only assume that the impersonal approach of communication by phone, fax, mail and email to explain eligibility, program details, inter-agency coordination and care providers will lead to much confusion and lost time.

Aloha kakou,

Recently a decision was made to shut down Med Quest offices and Outstations throughout the State of Hawai'i and consolidate services to 2 main offices, basically "calling centers". The rationale behind this decision does NOT meet the needs of the public. Instead it will create more hardship, more confusion and a lot more people without healthcare, the very thing the nation is trying to improve on.

My name is Karin Hokoana and I am a Patient Care Advocate at Maui Memorial Medical Center in Wailuku on the island of Maui.

Maui is now experiencing a huge increase in unemployment, increasing numbers in foreclosures, huge reductions in pay, bankruptcies and foreclosures. For years Maui has always appeared as the State's orphan, very often not getting services or benefits rightfully due its residents. This has forced some of us to spend huge amounts to get to Oahu to get help. We can no longer afford the luxury of flying everywhere to get what we rightfully deserve or need.

Considering the underserved population, how does one expect they have the means to use a computer for forms or to fax a form in? Don't they have the right to see the person tasked to review their situation? Actually get their questions answered **IN PERSON?**

I deal with the less fortunate population on this island and currently maintain over 1700 files of clients that cannot afford their medication or are un/under insured. Often we have on our doorstep, the resident that has lost everything. Having the ability to assist them in obtaining at least health care is an appreciated, precious gift to them.

Our culture cannot be compared to the mainland. And considering past failures, one would think the powers that be would not consider what works for other States would work here. We barely have enough to get by on, yet there seems to be enough money to hire on "consultants" with no knowledge of our culture to come in and tell us what to do. When you live on the continent, there is always a way to get to an office to help. Here, the ocean and its wave divides us and these paid "experts" fail to see that. The phone IS NOT NOR WILL IT EVER BE a substitute for Aloha.

Since it is a given that Governor Lingle and Director Koller will be leaving their posts soon, one can hope that the next leader knows what it is like to be

poor and starts cutting the budget in areas that don't hurt those already hurting.

Send the "consultant" (Hoback) back where he came from and demand back the State's monies paid him for his poor assessment and culture ignorant recommendations.

### Value of Face-to-Face Service with Eligibility worker

I work with clients 60 years of age or older providing nursing case management. Many of my clients have cognitive impairment and are confused about the DHS process when applying and keeping their benefits year after year. A lapse in <sup>benefits can mean 3 months without their</sup> medications ~~and~~ treatments.

I have ~~had~~ worked closely with the eligibility workers over the past 10 years especially with families making the difficult decision of placing their loved one in a long term care facility. The process of LTC placement is overwhelming.

case presentations:

① couple who are from Chuuk.

Husband has dementia and is on coumadin (warfarin) therapy. Wife was on dialysis (she has since passed). Last year they did not get paperwork in on time and it took 3 mos to restart services. In addition, talk of a Basic Health Plan has caused anxiety in husband who is no longer compliant with his medication <sup>medical follow-up</sup> regimen because he is worried about un~~seen~~ charges.

② Couple - wife caregiver for spouse x 1 yr. Husband has severe dementia + behavior challenges (aggression). He failed <sup>to be at having to have community based services.</sup>

working with Eligibility worker we were able to push the system to get admission to Nursing facility when a lead was a min. 600.
