Petition to stop O'ahu Wind Power Partners LLC, and the State of Hawai'i Department of Land and Natural Resources from developing proposed wind farm at or near the area locally known as "Cross Hill" which is located within the State of Hawai'i Agricultural Park directly behind Ko'olauloa Housing.

We, the undersigned, collectively oppose the placement of large wind turbines on Cross Hill by O'ahu Wind Power Partners LLC, or any other entity. The proposed buffer zone is less than commonly recommended. The elevated site and its close proximity to residential housing may increase the potential of a catastrophic event. We oppose the placement of these towers and turbines on this particular elevated site due to unacceptable health and safety factors. Despite our support of alternative energy and assurances of safety from the developer we believe:

- That due to the close proximity of the project to residential housing, the noise and subsonic vibrations generated by these turbines will have a negative impact on residents' health.
- The development of this project will negatively impact homeowners' property values.
- That similar turbines placed in Kahuku have had catastrophic failures and due to their remote location, no injuries occurred. However, the close proximity of four towers and turbines to residential housing, a catastrophic failure may cause injuries or worse to nearby residents.

Therefore, we call upon you, our public officials, to join our efforts to protect and serve the residents of Kahuku by requiring the developer and the DLNR to abandon their plans to place towers and turbines on Cross Hill. In addition, we urge you to protect other communities across the State of Hawai'i by requiring wind farm developers to create a health and safety buffer zone of at least 4000 ft. We ask that you deny all related permit and zoning requests at the County and State level. It is the responsibility of government and those we elect to serve all persons in this generation and future generations through the enactment and enforcement of laws that secure a safe and healthy environment for their constituents.
