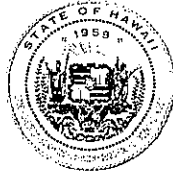

The HHFDC supports S.C.R. 61, which authorizes the fee simple sale of vacant, non-
ceded, parcels located in Hokulele, Kaneohe, Hawaii, pursuant to Act 176, Session
Laws of Hawaii 2009. These parcels are the remainder of the Hokulele development,
and located in part beneath the H-3 Freeway. The HHFDC is respectfully requesting
approval of the fee simple sale of all or a portion of these parcels, while reserving the
right to transfer the portion beneath the H-3 Freeway to the Department of
Transportation, if the Department so desires.
