- 2) **Repair various areas damaged by termites;**
- 3) **Upgrade electrical wiring;**
- 4) **Repair or replace window shutters at the Barracks;**
- 5) **Repair various historic doors and related hardware;**
- 6) **Repair or replace center flagpole on top of 'Iolani Palace;**

**7) Upgrade security equipment in various locations.**

**Grant monies are to cover costs incurred from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.**

**This application is to provide direct financial assistance for capital improvements to Iolani Palace and other historic structures within the 11-acre Palace complex. For these projects, work performed by outside contractors is supervised by Palace security and reviewed by a Facilities Manager and the Curator. If the work includes historic preservation, The Friends will also consult with the State Historic Preservation Office.**



**DECLARATION STATEMENT

CHAPTER 42F, HAWAII REVISIED STATUTES**

The undersigned authorized representative of the applicant acknowledges that said applicant meets and will comply with all of the following standards for the award of grants and subsidies pursuant to section 42F-103, Hawaii Revised Statutes:

- (1) Is licensed or accredited, in accordance with federal, state, or county statutes, rules, or ordinances, to conduct the activities or provide the services for which a grant or subsidy is awarded;


- (1) Has been determined and designated to be a non-profit organization by the Internal Revenue Service; and
