


A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR THE DISABLED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-54, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "~~§291-54 Display of removable and temporary removable~~
- 4 ~~windshield placards.~~ The placard shall be displayed in such a
- 5 manner that it may be viewed from the front and rear of the
- 6 vehicle by hanging it from the front windshield rearview mirror
- 7 of a vehicle [~~utilizing a parking space reserved for persons~~
- 8 ~~with disabilities. When there is no rearview mirror,~~] when the
- 9 placard is in use. If the design of the rearview mirror
- 10 precludes hanging the placard in a secure manner, the placard
- 11 shall be displayed on the dashboard."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
