
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPED INSTRUCTION PERMITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-110, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:

3 "(d) Except when operating a [~~motor scooter~~] moped, motor
4 scooter, or motorcycle, the holder of an instruction permit
5 shall be accompanied by a person who is twenty-one years of age
6 or older and licensed to operate the category of motor vehicles
7 in which the motor vehicle that is being operated belongs. The
8 licensed person shall occupy a passenger seat beside the permit
9 holder while the motor vehicle is being operated; provided that
10 if the holder of the instruction permit is under the age of
11 eighteen years and is driving between the hours of 11:00 p.m.
12 and 5:00 a.m.:

13 (1) A licensed driver who is the permit holder's parent or
14 guardian shall occupy a passenger seat beside the
15 driver while the motor vehicle is operated, unless the
16 permit holder is an emancipated minor;

17 (2) The licensed driver shall be licensed to operate the
18 same category of motor vehicles as the motor vehicle



1 being operated by the holder of the instruction
2 permit; and
3 (3) All occupants of the motor vehicle shall be restrained
4 by a seat belt assembly or a child passenger safety
5 restraint system as required under sections 291-11.5
6 and 291-11.6, notwithstanding any other law to the
7 contrary.

8 (e) No holder of a temporary instruction permit shall
9 operate a [~~motorcycle or a motor scooter~~] moped, motor scooter,
10 or motorcycle during hours of darkness or carry any passengers."

11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
