
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1502.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 "**§302A-1502.6 Providers of construction or project-related**
4 **[professional] services for the repair and maintenance of public**
5 **schools; volunteer status; coordinator position established.**

6 (a) Pursuant to chapter 90, the department shall accept as
7 volunteers ~~[qualified]~~:

8 (1) Parents, legal guardians, students, and members of the
9 community; and

10 (2) Qualified professional providers of construction or
11 project-related professional services who are under
12 contract with Hawaii 3R's,

13 to provide construction or project-related services for the
14 repair and maintenance of public schools.

15 The department shall maintain a list of volunteers so
16 accepted, and shall provide the ~~[professional providers]~~
17 volunteers with appropriate guidance, supervision, and control
18 to reasonably protect members of the public from injury or



1 damage. Once accepted as a volunteer by the department, the
 2 [~~professional provider~~] volunteer shall be entitled to
 3 protection from liability for volunteers under chapter 90,
 4 unless the injury or damage is caused by or is the result of the
 5 [~~professional provider's~~] volunteer's wilful and wanton act or
 6 omission."

7 (b) There is established, within the department of
 8 education, a coordinator position to coordinate the public and
 9 private efforts to repair and maintain public schools; provided
 10 that the coordinator shall serve at the pleasure of the
 11 superintendent and may be established as a permanent position
 12 not subject to chapter 76."

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
