
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
2 accounting and general services central services division
3 repairs and alterations program is responsible for providing
4 major, minor, and emergency repair services and minor alteration
5 services for one hundred sixty-four state office buildings and
6 facilities. Services include repairs and alterations of
7 buildings, monitoring and regulating the air conditioning in
8 designated buildings, managing contracts for elevators and air
9 conditioning maintenance, and providing oversight of the work
10 performed by contracted service providers. In addition, the
11 department's public works division planning, design, and
12 construction program provides a full range of planning, design,
13 and construction management services for all agencies of the
14 executive branch and for others upon request.

15 In meeting the mandates of these programs, the department
16 faces increasing costs related to energy consumption, health and
17 safety requirements, natural disasters, and energy-efficiency
18 projects, as well as the challenges that budget cuts and



1 furloughs have placed on the department's ability to manage its
2 resources more efficiently and minimize a backlog of requests
3 for services.

4 The purpose of this Act is to provide the department with
5 additional sources of funds to support the department's mission
6 to establish and maintain a clean, safe, and pleasant building
7 work environment; maintain safe and aesthetically pleasing
8 grounds at state buildings and facilities; and provide timely,
9 quality, cost-effective, and innovative repair and alteration
10 services for public buildings and facilities statewide.

11 SECTION 2. Section 107-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

13 "(b) The comptroller shall make [~~reasonable~~] assessments
14 on construction projects managed by the department of accounting
15 and general services to carry out the program of centralized
16 engineering services. The assessments shall be [~~based on a~~
17 ~~logarithmic curve developed by the department for such~~
18 ~~services.~~] per cent of all state fund appropriations for
19 capital improvements designated for the construction cost
20 element; provided that assessment moneys shall apply only to
21 capital improvement appropriations that are designated for the
22 construction or renovation of state buildings. All assessments



1 collected shall be deposited into the public works project
2 assessment fund."

3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
