
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012 for the
5 purpose of capital improvement projects for the nineteenth
6 representative district, as follows:

2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital
5 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
6 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
