
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 710-1021, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

3 "(1) A person commits the offense of escape in the second
4 degree if [~~the~~]:

5 (a) The person intentionally escapes from a correctional
6 or detention facility or from custody[-]; or

7 (b) The person knowingly fails to appear at a correctional
8 facility or detention facility by the time and date
9 ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction, for the
10 service of a term of custody or confinement ordered by
11 the court."

12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14 begun before its effective date.

15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
