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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) There is established within the governor's  
2 office for administrative purposes a temporary task force to  
3 review and update the Hawaii state planning act and the  
4 planning, programming, and budgeting system of the State. The  
5 governor shall convene the task force within thirty days after  
6 the effective date of this Act.

7           (b) The task force shall be composed of:

8           (1) The chairperson of the senate ways and means committee  
9           or the chairperson's designee;

10          (2) The chairperson of the house finance committee or the  
11          chairperson's designee;

12          (3) The chairperson of the senate water, land, and housing  
13          committee or the chairperson's designee;

14          (4) The chairperson of the house water, land, and ocean  
15          resources committee or the chairperson's designee;

16          (5) The chairperson of the senate economic development and  
17          technology committee or the chairperson's designee;



- 1           (6) The chairperson of the house economic revitalization  
2           and business committee or the chairperson's designee;
- 3           (7) A member appointed by the president of the senate;
- 4           (8) A member appointed by the speaker of the house of  
5           representatives;
- 6           (9) The director of budget and finance or the director's  
7           designee;
- 8           (10) The comptroller or the comptroller's designee;
- 9           (11) The director of the office of planning or the  
10          director's designee;
- 11          (12) The chairperson of the board of directors of the  
12          chamber of commerce of Hawaii or the chairperson's  
13          designee;
- 14          (13) The executive director of the economic research  
15          organization at the University of Hawaii (UHERO) or  
16          the executive director's designee;
- 17          (14) The chairperson of the board of directors of the  
18          Hawaii tourism authority or the chairperson's  
19          designee; and
- 20          (15) The president of the tax foundation of Hawaii or the  
21          president's designee.
- 22          (c) The members of the task force shall:



- 1           (1) Select the chairperson of the task force from among  
2           the members themselves; and
- 3           (2) Serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for  
4           necessary expenses, including travel expenses,  
5           incurred in the performance of their official duties  
6           under this Act.

7           (d) The chairperson of the task force may select  
8 additional task force members at the chairperson's discretion.

9           (e) The office of planning shall provide all  
10 administrative, technical, professional, and clerical support  
11 required by the task force for matters pertaining to the review  
12 and update of the state planning act.

13           The department of budget and finance shall provide all  
14 administrative, technical, professional, and clerical support  
15 required by the task force for matters pertaining to the review  
16 and update of the planning, programming, and budgeting system.

17           (f) The task force shall submit a report of its findings  
18 and recommendations, including proposed legislation, to the  
19 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
20 each regular session, beginning with the 2012 regular session.

21           (g) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 2015.
