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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ROADS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance shall transfer from the  
2 general fund to the credit of the state highway fund created in  
3 section 248-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$           or  
4 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012  
5 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
6 fiscal year 2012-2013 for the operation, maintenance, and repair  
7 of roads as provided for under section 248-9(a)(4), Hawaii  
8 Revised Statutes, for any county having a population of greater  
9 than five hundred thousand residents.


10           SECTION 2. It is the intent of this Act not to jeopardize  
11 the receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of  
12 the State or any agency thereof to the holders of any bond  
13 issued by the State or any such agency, and to the extent, and  
14 only to the extent, necessary to effectuate this intent, the  
15 governor may modify the strict provisions of this Act, but shall  
16 promptly report any such modification with reasons therefor to  
17 the legislature at its next session thereafter for review by the  
18 legislature.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
