
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SALARIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 85, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is amended
2 by amending section 2 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary
4 and notwithstanding the recommendations of the commission on
5 salaries for salary increases, beginning July 1, 2009, and until
6 June 30, [~~2011~~] 2013, the annual salaries of the governor, the
7 lieutenant governor, the justices and judges of all state
8 courts, the administrative director of the State or an
9 equivalent position, and the department heads or executive
10 officers and the deputies or assistants to the department heads
11 or executive officers of the departments of:

- 12 (1) Accounting and general services;
13 (2) Agriculture;
14 (3) The attorney general;
15 (4) Budget and finance;
16 (5) Business, economic development, and tourism;
17 (6) Commerce and consumer affairs;
18 (7) Defense;



- 1 (8) Hawaiian home lands;
2 (9) Health;
3 (10) Human resources development;
4 (11) Human services;
5 (12) Labor and industrial relations;
6 (13) Land and natural resources;
7 (14) Public safety;
8 (15) Taxation; and
9 (16) Transportation,

10 shall be reduced by five per cent from what the salary is as of
11 June 30, 2009, and shall remain at that salary rate until
12 June 30, [~~2011~~] 2013; provided that on July 1, [~~2011~~] 2013,
13 the salaries of these positions shall be restored to the level
14 they would have been on July 1, 2009, without the salary
15 decrease under this Act; provided further that the
16 recommendations of the commission on salaries for salary
17 increases for these positions effective July 1, 2012, shall
18 become effective on that date in accordance with the
19 recommendations.

20 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary and
21 notwithstanding the recommendations of the commission on
22 salaries for salary increases, beginning July 1, 2009, and until



1 June 30, [~~2011,~~] 2013, the annual salaries of members of the
2 legislature shall be reduced by five per cent from what the
3 salary is as of June 30, 2009; provided that on July 1, [~~2011,~~]
4 2013, the salaries of the legislators shall be restored to the
5 level [~~it~~] they would have been on July 1, 2009, without the
6 salary decrease under this Act; provided further that the
7 recommendations of the commission on salaries for salary
8 increases for legislators effective January 1, 2012, shall
9 become effective on that date in accordance with the
10 recommendations.

11 (c) For the period from July 1, 2009, to July 1, 2011,
12 notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the leaves of absence
13 for vacation and sick leave, with pay, of persons affected under
14 subsection (a) and (b) shall be the same as those negotiated,
15 mediated, or arbitrated under chapter 89, Hawaii Revised
16 Statutes, for collective bargaining unit (13); provided that on
17 July 1, 2011, the leaves of absence under this subsection shall
18 be restored to the level they would have been on July 1, 2009,
19 but for this subsection.

20 (d) This section shall not be construed to impart any
21 right to additional compensation previously authorized through
22 the adoption of the commission on salaries' recommendations for:



1 (1) The period from January 1, 2009, through July 1,
2 [~~2011~~] 2013, for positions covered under subsection
3 (a); and

4 (2) The period from January 1, 2009, through December 31,
5 [~~2011~~] 2013, for positions covered under subsection
6 (b).

7 (e) This section shall not be enforced to the extent that
8 it is preempted by federal law."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2011.
