
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL PARKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 166-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "agricultural park" to
3 read as follows:

4 ""Agricultural park" means any agricultural or aquacultural
5 complex so designated by the board, for which state land or
6 state funds are used, in order to meet the goals and objectives
7 stated in section 166-1~~[-]~~; provided that agricultural parks may
8 include:

9 (1) Agricultural buildings, farm residences, and employee
10 dwellingings necessary to the production and distribution
11 of agricultural and aquacultural commodities [may be
12 considered part of the agricultural park.];

13 (2) Facilities for agricultural education;

14 (3) Agricultural learning centers; and

15 (4) State health department-certified kitchens."


16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
