
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. By no later than July 1, 2012, the Hawaii
2 medical board shall adopt, amend, or repeal rules, pursuant to
3 chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to require physician
4 clinical practitioners to complete twelve hours of continuing
5 medical education on palliative care every four years in order
6 to maintain licensure. This requirement shall become effective
7 on January 1, 2013, and not apply to non-clinical physicians.

8 For the purposes of this Act, "non-clinical physicians"
9 includes but is not limited to:

- 10 (1) Medical examiners;
11 (2) Nuclear medicine doctors;
12 (3) Pathologists;
13 (4) Podiatrists;
14 (5) Public health physicians;
15 (6) Sports medicine physicians; and
16 (7) Physicians performing strictly administrative
17 functions.
