
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342H-37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Felony disposal of solid waste is a class C felony
4 for which a [~~maximum fine of~~] fine of not less than \$2,000 but
5 not more than \$50,000 for each separate offense [~~may~~] shall be
6 imposed."

7 SECTION 2. Section 342H-39, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

9 "(b) Petty misdemeanor disposal of solid waste is
10 punishable by:

11 (1) A fine of not less than \$500 but not more than \$25,000
12 for each separate offense;

13 (2) Not more than thirty days imprisonment for each
14 offense; or

15 (3) Revocation or suspension by court order of any
16 contractor's license or any applicable certificate of
17 authorization from the public utilities commission.

18 Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense."

1 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
