
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO POWER OF ATTORNEY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 551D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§551D- Notice of designation and subsequent acts. A
5 designated attorney-in-fact who is a child of the principal
6 shall provide:

7 (1) A written copy of the executed power of attorney; and

8 (2) Notice of any acts taken pursuant to the power of
9 attorney;


10 to any other child of the principal who is not designated as an
11 attorney-in-fact of the principal."

12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
