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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2011-2012.

5 1. To be expended by the University of Hawaii at Hilo:

6       A. Student housing

20           the Hilo bayfront for serious safety and


3 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective capital  
 4 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
 5 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital  
 7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at the  
 8 end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made;  
 9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as of  
 10 June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
