22	including but not limited to dirt track and drag racing would be
23	ideal on the island of Oahu; now, therefore,

27	of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Land and
28	Natural Resources and Hawaii Community Development Authority are

30	a motorsports center on the island of Oahu; and
