
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CREATE A NEW LANE
ON LILIHA STREET BETWEEN KING STREET AND VINEYARD
BOULEVARD.

1 WHEREAS, Liliha Street between King Street and Vineyard
2 Boulevard experiences an inordinate amount of traffic; and

4 WHEREAS, the residents that live in the area that use the
5 limited amount of street parking add to the congestion of Liliha
6 Street between King Street and Vineyard Boulevard; and

8 WHEREAS, the ensuing gridlock adds to the frustration of
9 the residents of the area; and

11 WHEREAS, widening the stretch of Liliha Street between King
12 Street and Vineyard Boulevard would help alleviate the traffic
13 congestion by improving the flow of traffic through the area;

16 WHEREAS, widening the stretch of Liliha Street between King
17 Street and Vineyard Boulevard would help alleviate some of the
18 frustrations of the residents in the area; and

20 WHEREAS, widening the stretch of Liliha Street between King
21 Street and Vineyard Boulevard would also help and encourage
22 economic growth through the expanding and fixing of vital
23 infrastructure; now, therefore,

27 of 2011, the Senate concurring, urges the Department of
28 Transportation to create a new lane on Liliha Street between
