## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SYSTEM  
AND ALL OF ITS INDIVIDUAL CAMPUSES.

1           WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii system is comprised of  
2 ten campuses located on four different islands; and  
3

4           WHEREAS, having smaller campuses on different islands might  
5 render the University of Hawaii system less efficient than  
6 university systems in other states; and  
7

8           WHEREAS, college and university campuses generally need to  
9 have larger populations of students in order to realize certain  
10 economies of scale such that economies of scale generally work  
11 against smaller isle campuses; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, the Auditor is charged with the responsibility of  
14 conducting postaudits of the transactions, accounts, programs,  
15 and performance of all departments, offices, and agencies of the  
16 State and its political subdivisions; and  
17

18           WHEREAS, the postaudits and examinations are conducted to  
19 discover evidence of any unauthorized, illegal, irregular,  
20 improper, or unsafe handling or expenditure of state funds or  
21 other improper practice of financial administration; now,  
22 therefore,

24           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
25 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
26 of 2011, that the Auditor is requested to conduct a management  
27 audit of the University of Hawaii system and all of its  
28 individual campuses in order to identify instances of  
29 unintentional redundancies and to recommend system improvements;

32           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to  
33 submit a report of any findings and recommendations, including  
34 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature not later than

1 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of

5 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, the Chairperson of the  
6 Board of Regents of the University of Hawaii, and the President  
7 of the University of Hawaii.
