HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SYSTEM AND ALL OF ITS INDIVIDUAL CAMPUSES.

WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii system is comprised of 1 ten campuses located on four different islands; and 2 3 WHEREAS, having smaller campuses on different islands might 4 5 render the University of Hawaii system less efficient than university systems in other states; and 6 7 WHEREAS, college and university campuses generally need to 8 have larger populations of students in order to realize certain 9 economies of scale such that economies of scale generally work 10 against smaller isle campuses; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the Auditor is charged with the responsibility of 13 conducting postaudits of the transactions, accounts, programs, 14 and performance of all departments, offices, and agencies of the 15 State and its political subdivisions; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, the postaudits and examinations are conducted to discover evidence of any unauthorized, illegal, irregular, 19 improper, or unsafe handling or expenditure of state funds or 20 other improper practice of financial administration; now, 21 therefore, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 24 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 25 of 2011, that the Auditor is requested to conduct a management 26 audit of the University of Hawaii system and all of its 27 individual campuses in order to identify instances of 28 unintentional redundancies and to recommend system improvements; 29 and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 32 submit a report of any findings and recommendations, including 33 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature not later than 34
