
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 INTRODUCTION

3 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 89-10(b),
4 Hawaii Revised Statutes, states:

5 *"(b) All cost items shall be subject to*
6 *appropriations by the appropriate legislative bodies.*
7 *. . . The state legislature or the legislative bodies*
8 *of the counties acting in concert, as the case may be,*
9 *may approve or reject the cost items submitted to*
10 *them, as a whole. If the state legislature or the*
11 *legislative body of any county rejects any of the cost*
12 *items submitted to them, all cost items submitted*
13 *shall be returned to the parties for further*
14 *bargaining."*

15 The purpose of this Act is to authorize cost items
16 submitted to the legislature for bargaining units represented by
17 the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly, and for officers
18 and employees who are excluded from collective bargaining but



1 belong to the same compensation plans as those officers and
2 employees within corresponding bargaining units, which are
3 applicable to fiscal years 2011-2012, and 2012-2013.

4 This Act solely reflects the legislature's approval of cost
5 items for fiscal years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 and should not be
6 construed as approval for cost items for any other fiscal year.

7 PART II

8 UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY

9 SECTION 3. There are appropriated or authorized from the
10 sources of funding indicated below to health premium payments -
11 state (BUF 761) the following sums or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2011-2013 the Hawaii
13 employer-union health benefits trust fund costs contained in the
14 collective bargaining agreement negotiated with the exclusive
15 bargaining representative of collective bargaining unit (7):

 3 state (BUF 761) the following sums or so much thereof as may be
 4 necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2011-2013 the Hawaii
 5 employer-union health benefits trust fund costs authorized by
 6 chapter 89C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for state officers and
 7 employees in the executive branch who are excluded from
 8 collective bargaining and belong to the same compensation plans
 9 as those officers and employees within bargaining unit (7):

12 Funds appropriated or authorized by this section shall be
 13 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state
 14 departments or agencies for expenditure in the respective fiscal

16 SECTION 5. There are appropriated or authorized from the
 17 sources of funding indicated below to departmental
 18 administration and budget division (BUF 101) the following sums
 19 or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal
 20 biennium 2011-2013 all collective bargaining cost items in the
 21 collective bargaining agreement negotiated with the exclusive
 22 bargaining representative of collective bargaining unit (7):

12 administration and budget division (BUF 101) the following sums
13 or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal
14 biennium 2011-2013 cost items authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii
15 Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees in the
16 executive branch who are excluded from collective bargaining and
17 belong to the same compensation plans as those officers and
18 employees within collective bargaining unit (7):

2 The funds appropriated or authorized by this section shall
3 be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state
4 departments or agencies for expenditure in each respective
5 fiscal year for the purposes of this part.

6 PART III

7 ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

8 SECTION 7. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
9 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
10 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
11 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
12 from the respective funds.

13 SECTION 8. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
14 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2012, and
15 June 30, 2013, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
16 those dates.

17 SECTION 9. If any provision of this Act, or the
18 application thereof to any person or circumstances is held
19 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
20 applications of the Act which can be given effect without the
21 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provision
22 of this Act are severable.



1 SECTION 10. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
