
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to amend Act 191,
5 Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, which appropriated moneys from the
6 emergency and budget reserve fund to maintain the levels of
7 programs determined to be essential to education, public health,
8 and public welfare for fiscal year 2010-2011.

9 The existing language of certain appropriations in Act 191
10 makes it difficult to carry out the legislature's intention of
11 awarding moneys to specific organizations. This Act provides
12 technical corrections to Act 191 to permit the awarding of
13 moneys to specified organizations and extends the lapse date of
14 Act 191's appropriations from June 30, 2011, to June 30, 2012.

15 SECTION 3. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is as
16 follows:

17 1. By adding a new section to read:



1 "SECTION 24A. There is appropriated out of the emergency
2 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3 \$1,900,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2010-2011 to the Hawaii Primary Care Association for adult
5 dental care provided at federally qualified health centers;
6 provided that the funds shall not be used for any other purpose.
7 The governor is authorized to utilize enhanced federal medical
8 assistance percentages funds to offset the amount appropriated;
9 provided that the total amount shall not exceed \$1,900,000. The
10 department of human services shall prepare a report on:
11 (1) The number of adults receiving these benefits;
12 (2) The cost per person;
13 (3) Total breakdown of administrative costs and other
14 overhead costs; and
15 (4) Statistics, if available, on how this dental program
16 is reducing the number of emergency dental-related
17 medical procedures;
18 provided further that the department of human services shall
19 submit its report to the legislature no later than twenty days
20 prior to the convening of the 2012 regular session. The sum
21 appropriated shall be expended by the department of human



1 services for the purposes of this Act. This is a grant pursuant
2 to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes."

3 2. By adding two new sections to read:

4 "SECTION 40A. Any unexpended or unencumbered balances of
5 any appropriation made by this Act as of the close of business
6 on June 30, 2011, shall not lapse; provided that all moneys from
7 the appropriations that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2012,
8 shall lapse to the emergency and budget reserve fund.

9 SECTION 40B. There is appropriated out of the emergency
10 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
11 \$100,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
12 2010-2011 for the Maui Community College, University of Hawaii,
13 for the adult dental care program.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 human services for the purposes of this Act."

16 SECTION 4. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
17 amended as follows:

18 1. By amending section 12 to read:

19 "SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the emergency
20 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
21 \$332,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
22 2010-2011 for the Waianae District Comprehensive Health and



1 Hospital Board, Incorporated to support its emergency room
2 services. This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
3 Revised Statutes.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 health for the purposes of this Act."

6 2. By amending section 16 to read:

7 "SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the emergency
8 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
9 \$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
10 2010-2011 for Kokua Kalihi Valley Comprehensive Family Services.
11 This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
12 Statutes.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14 health for the purposes of this Act."

15 3. By amending sections 18 and 19 to read:

16 "SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the emergency
17 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
18 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
19 2010-2011 for the Windward Spouse Abuse Shelter. This is a
20 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
22 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 19. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000
 3 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
 4 for the Blueprint for Change Program for Neighborhood Place
 5 Walk-in Centers. This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F,
 6 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 8 human services for the purposes of this Act."

9 4. By amending sections 21 and 22 to read:

10 "SECTION 21. There is appropriated out of the emergency
 11 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
 12 \$762,500 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
 13 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to support domestic violence shelters
 15 statewide[-] and to be distributed as follows:

16	(1) <u>Child and Family Service</u>	
17	(A) <u>Two shelters on Oahu</u>	\$206,429
18	(B) <u>Two shelters on Big Island</u>	\$206,429
19	(2) <u>Parents and Children Together</u>	\$103,214
20	(3) <u>Women Helping Women</u>	\$103,214
21	(4) <u>Molokai Community Service Council, Inc.</u>	\$40,000



1 SECTION 31. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000
 3 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
 4 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
 5 Revised Statutes, for domestic violence services[-] and to be
 6 distributed as follows:

7	(1) <u>Child and Family Service (Oahu)</u>	<u>\$112,161</u>
8	(2) <u>Child and Family Service (Big Island)</u>	<u>\$170,492</u>
9	(3) <u>Domestic Violence Action Center</u>	<u>\$391,192</u>
10	(4) <u>Molokai Community Service Council, Inc.</u>	<u>\$35,000</u>
11	(5) <u>Parents and Children Together</u>	<u>\$225,000</u>
12	(6) <u>Young Women's Christian Association</u>	
13	<u>(YWCA) of Kauai</u>	<u>\$30,000</u>

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
 15 the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 32. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 17 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000
 18 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
 19 for Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii to provide pro bono legal
 20 services for indigent persons. This is a grant pursuant to
 21 chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
2 the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 33. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$720,000
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
6 for the Legal Aid Society of Hawaii to provide general civil
7 legal services. This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
8 Revised Statutes.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
10 the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
12 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$282,000
13 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
14 for the Hawaii Family Law Clinic to provide services to obtain
15 temporary restraining orders. This is a grant pursuant to
16 chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
18 the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 35. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
20 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000
21 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
22 for Catholic Charities Hawaii to provide intra-familial sex



1 assault services. This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F,
2 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
4 the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 36. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
6 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000
7 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
8 for the Children's Alliance of Hawaii, Inc. to provide child sex
9 assault services. This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F,
10 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
12 the purposes of this Act."

13 6. By amending sections 38 and 39 to read:

14 "SECTION 38. There is appropriated out of the emergency
15 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
16 \$75,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
17 2010-2011 to the [~~YMCA~~] Young Men's Christian Association of
18 Honolulu for the Weed and Seed Program. This is a grant
19 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 39. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$466,000
 3 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
 4 for the Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children for the
 5 sex abuse treatment center for statewide sex assault services.
 6 This is a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
 7 Statutes.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 9 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act."

10 SECTION 5. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010 is amended
 11 by repealing Section 24:

12 [~~SECTION 24. There is appropriated out of the emergency~~
 13 ~~and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii for QUEST health~~
 14 ~~care payments, the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much thereof as may~~
 15 ~~be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for the restoration of~~
 16 ~~adult dental care formerly granted under program ID HMS 245~~
 17 ~~QUEST health care payments; provided that the funds shall not be~~
 18 ~~expended for any other purpose. The governor is authorized to~~
 19 ~~utilize enhanced federal medical assistance percentages (FMAP)~~
 20 ~~funds to offset the amount appropriated, provided that the total~~
 21 ~~amount shall not exceed \$2,000,000. Any unexpended funds shall~~
 22 ~~lapse to their respective funds.~~

14 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
