A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KAHOO LAWE ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6K-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§6K-5~~ **Commission.** (a) There is established the
4 Kaho'olawe island reserve commission to be placed within the
5 department of land and natural resources for administrative
6 purposes as provided in section 26-35. The commission shall
7 consist of [~~seven~~] five members to be appointed in the manner
8 and to serve for the terms provided in section 26-34; provided
9 that:

10 (1) [~~One member shall be a member of the Protect Kaho'olawe~~
11 ~~Ohana,~~

12 ~~(2)]~~ Two members shall be appointed by the governor [~~from a~~
13 ~~list provided by the Protect Kaho'olawe Ohana,~~] in
14 consultation with native Hawaiian organizations;

15 ~~(3)]~~ (2) One member shall be a trustee or representative
16 of the office of Hawaiian affairs;



1 ~~[(4)]~~ (3) One member shall be a county official appointed
2 by the governor from a list provided by the mayor of
3 the county of Maui; and

4 ~~[(5)]~~ (4) One member shall be the chairperson of the board
5 of land and natural resources [~~and~~

6 ~~(6) One member shall be appointed by the governor from a~~
7 ~~list provided by native Hawaiian organizations].~~

8 (b) The governor shall appoint the chairperson from among
9 the members of the commission.

10 (c) The members of the commission shall serve without pay
11 but shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses,
12 including travel expenses, incurred in carrying out their
13 duties.

14 (d) Any action taken by the commission shall be approved
15 by a simple majority of its members. [~~Four~~] Three members shall
16 constitute a quorum to do business.

17 (e) No member shall be reappointed to the commission
18 within four years from the last day of the member's service
19 immediately preceding the reappointment to the commission.

20 ~~[(e)]~~ (f) The commission, without regard to the
21 requirements of chapter 76, may hire employees necessary to
22 perform its duties."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
