1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for a
4 grant-in-aid to the Lahainaluna High School Foundation for
5 completion of the stadium renovation project at Lahainaluna high
6 school in Lahaina, Maui, including lights, a track, a press box,
7 and renovation of the former cafeteria building as follows:

8	Design	\$75,000
9	Construction	\$2,730,000
10	Total funding	\$2,805,000

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12 education for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
14 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
16 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
17 of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
19 capital projects set forth in sections 1 and 2 shall be expended
20 by the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
21 provided that:



- 1 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 6 shall be
2 expended by the department of education;
3 (2) The sums appropriated in items 7 and 8 shall be
4 expended by the department of transportation.

5 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
