A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify that the
2 solid waste management surcharge applies to all solid waste
3 disposal facilities that receive solid waste for ultimate
4 disposal through landfilling, incineration, or through a waste-
5 to-energy facility, whether the waste is disposed of in-state or
6 transferred out-of-state.

7 SECTION 2. Section 342G-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

9 "(a) There is established a solid waste management
10 surcharge. The solid waste management surcharge shall be 35
11 cents per ton of solid waste disposed of [~~within~~]:

12 (1) Within the State at permitted or unpermitted solid
13 waste disposal facilities[-], incineration facilities,
14 and waste-to-energy facilities; or

15 (2) Transferred to solid waste reduction facilities within
16 the State that collect solid waste for transport to an
17 out-of-state landfill, incineration facility, or
18 waste-to-energy facility.



1 The surcharge shall be paid by the person or entity doing the
 2 disposal[-] or the person or entity responsible for the
 3 preparation of the out-of-state transfer of collected solid
 4 waste. The owner or operator of the facility shall transfer all
 5 moneys collected from the surcharge to the department through a
 6 quarterly reporting and payment schedule. Estimates of
 7 quarterly solid waste disposal shall be submitted prior to the
 8 first day of each quarter and the transfer of moneys collected
 9 shall occur within thirty days of the end of each quarter."

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
